To All Kansas Sheriffs,

We are pleased to announce the Kansas Legal-Based Jail Guidelines are now available for sheriffs insured with KCAMP to utilize within their jails. Over 600 legal-based guidelines can be quickly accessed to know the most recent case law applicable to Kansas to assist jail administrators with policy and procedure development, officer and staff training, detailed rationale for answering inmate grievances, and many other benefits to keep jails constitutionally safe and proactively protect against liability.


With the full support of the Kansas Sheriffs' Association and the Kansas Jail Association, the **Kansas County Association Multiline Pool (KCAMP) has agreed to cover 100% of the implementation cost for KCAMP members.** This represents a considerable investment by KCAMP. The only remaining cost for participating is a monthly service fee payable by the individual county. Many participating agencies currently use their inmate commissary account funds to cover this cost. Monthly fees are as low as \$135 per month. Because there are fixed costs associated with maintaining the program, the monthly fee is lowered as more counties participate. The monthly fee includes all remote hosting, storage and backup of the online database, maintenance of the IT infrastructure, complimentary system updates throughout the term of the contract, user service support, and ongoing guideline updates as case law changes.

To provide a thorough demonstration of the Kansas Legal-Based Guidelines and to discuss the implementation of this new initiative statewide, we have set up regional training sessions July 11-13th, 2016 which we cordially invite all sheriffs and their jail commanders to attend. Exact regional locations and times will be announced in the near future but please block the dates so that someone from your agency can be there. Agencies that are not part of KCAMP can also participate and are invited to attend. We will also be providing references from agencies currently participating to give you direct feedback.
